Survey on Laryngeal Mask and Neonatal Resuscitation

Dear Colleagues,

At UENPS we think it is important to share best practice.

We are organising a SURVEY on *Laryngeal Mask and Neonatal Resuscitation* among healthcare providers. We urge you to take an active part and help us make the survey a success. This will allow to improve best practice across Europe.

In the recent years, the Laryngeal Mask (LM) has received increasing interest in the field of neonatal resuscitation. The LM was included in the algorithm of the American and European guidelines since 2015 and 2021 respectively, and the recent Consensus on Science of the neonatal ILCOR task force supports its use. Nevertheless, the use of the LM in the field of neonatal resuscitation is still limited.

The purpose of this survey is to find out how much the Laryngeal Mask is available in European birth centers and to understand the reasons for its apparent limited use.

The scientific project is a collaboration between Union of European Neonatal and Perinatal Societies (UENPS), European Resuscitation Council (ERC) and Italian Society of Neonatology (SIN). The project is also endorsed by ESPNIC. In this way, UENPS aims to help improve European standards of neonatal resuscitation.

Target populations for the survey are neonatologists, anesthesiologists, obstetricians, pediatricians, nurses, midwives, and pediatric residents - even if they do not have experience in using LM - across European countries.

Participants will need about 10 minutes to complete the questionnaire. Participation is entirely voluntary.
