Objectives

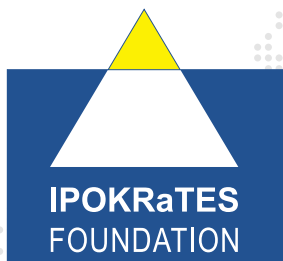
